Online Registration Information

Online registration will be the primary way to register. Registration for Spring League will open on December 15th. Please go to our website at www.rocksoccerclub.org and click the online registration "Go" button on the Home page or the Register page. If you are a returning player, enter your email and password. Passwords can be retrieved if forgotten. If you have not previously registered online, you will need to create an account as a new user.

If I register today what are my chances of my child being placed on a team?

What age group does my child fit into for '11/'12 season?

What is time commitment?

This is competitive soccer league, and therefore it is expected that the player will commit appropriate time to their team. Typically practices start towards the end of March and the official MAYSA Spring games dates are from mid-April to mid-June. Teams practice two times a week and play four home games and four away games. It is important that players participate in practice.

How do I pay and do I get registration confirmation?

Send checks and online registration receipt to PO Box 995, Janesville, WI 53547. When registering online, you can also use a credit card to pay, but there is an additional fee of \$6.75 for credit card use. We will send an email confirming your registration by January 8th. Receipt of payment is due January 31st. To arrange a later payment date, please contact our Treasurer, Dave Shanks. There will be late fee assessed after this date.

What help is there to cover the fee?

RSC is happy to offer scholarships to families in need of financial assistance. When registering, please complete a Reduced Fee Form available on [Forms](#) page of website and mail in with your registration. Questions please contact our Treasurer. We also strongly encourage parents to volunteer. A \$50 rebate is offered at the end of the season for those who volunteer. Please note interest when you register.

What information do you collect in the registration process?

Besides personal information such as parents, contact and address we also need physician information. We gather information on uniform needs and number, interest in volunteering, and review of key policies. We do not give away personal or email information. You can print copy of your registration and download any forms needed first week of practice.

Who places my child?

The RSC Board will meet with our Spring '11 Coaches to complete the placement process in January. Parents may make a placement request. We work closely with parents to ensure the appropriate placement but reserve right for final placement which we are happy to discuss.

What are the different leagues?

MAYSA Recreational Leagues

Madison Area Youth Soccer Association clubs are from the greater Dane County area. Our teams enter these leagues at 3rd grade. The majority of RSC teams participate in this league.

MAYSA Classic Leagues

This league starts in 5th grade and typically will involve tryouts. RSC will occasionally form teams based on players registered especially at the High School level.

WYSA Premier League

Wisconsin offers the next level of competition for select teams who travel the state. If players are suited for this league, RSC will direct parents/players to an appropriate club for consideration.

What programs do you have for younger children?

RSC offers an excellent In-house Skills program for children ages 3-10. However, if your child is entering 3rd grade or higher it may be appropriate to look at a competitive team for them. We are happy to discuss your child's situation with you. Registration for Spring Skills will occur in late January.

When will I be contacted by a coach and when are schedules available?

Coaches and/or team managers will contact players beginning of March. Schedules are typically not available from MAYSA until end of March.
